Subject: - **Filling up the post of Deputy Fire Adviser in the Directorate General (Fire Service, Civil Defence & Home Guards) unit of Ministry of Home Affairs.**

Sir/ Madam,

The Ministry of Home Affairs requires the services of a suitable officer for the post of Deputy Fire Adviser in the Directorate General (FS, CD & HG) in the Ministry of Home Affairs on deputation basis (including short term contract).

2. Following eligibility criteria is prescribed for filling up the post:

1) Deputation (including short term contract):

Officers of the Fire Brigades in the Central Government/State Governments/Municipal Corporations/Public Sector Undertakings or autonomous bodies under the direct control of the Central/State Governments: -

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis, or
(ii) with 5 years' regular service in the scale in Pay Band 3, Rupees 15600-39100 with grade pay of Rupees 5400 (pre-revised) or equivalent;

and

- (b) Possessing the following educational and other qualifications

ESSENTIAL

- (i) Bachelor degree in Fire Engineering from a recognized University
ii) 07 years' experience in Defence/ Civil Fire Service organization

3. Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation (ISTC) in another Ex-Cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization / department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

4. A copy of the existing Recruitment Rules, with Corrigendum, for the post of Deputy Fire Adviser in the Directorate General (Fire Service, Civil Defence & Home Guards) in the Ministry of Home Affairs is enclosed.

5. The post is General Central Service, Group "A" Gazetted Non-Ministerial post and carries pay scale of Rs. 15600-39100 in the Pay Band -3 with Grade Pay of Rs.6600 (pre-revised) plus usual allowances as admissible. Pay of the officer selected would be fixed as per the existing instructions of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. The Headquarters will be at New Delhi, but the officer selected would be liable to serve anywhere in India.



While forwarding the names, an integrity certificate and a certificate that no disciplinary action/proceedings, Vigilance case is either pending or contemplated against the officer may also be attached.

7. Officers who volunteer and are sponsored by their Ministry/Department/State Governments/UTs Administration etc. for the post will not be permitted to withdraw their names later.

8. State Governments are requested to circulate this post among their respective Municipal Corporations.

G.S.R. 56.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Deputy Fire Adviser Recruitment Rules, 1990, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Fire Adviser in the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. -

(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Deputy Fire Adviser Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale. -

The number of post, its classification pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached there to shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and qualifications, etc.-

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. - No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, have a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Ex-servicemen, and other special categories of persons, in accordance with orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
